The Eye-Q laser is the only system that preserves the natural curve of cornea, which eliminates the glare patients may experience from some technologies. Additionally, the reduced treatment time provides a more comfortable procedure for patients (dilation is not required) and is beneficial for treating high myopia (up to –12 diopters), high astigmatism and other time-intensive procedures.

“The Eye-Q will allow us to provide shorter, more comfortable procedures for our patients while maintaining the highest standards of quality and safety,” says Stulting.
